QUESTION 1 Though not many research agencies are too expressive about it, it is well documented that the benefits brought about by vigilantes groups are far outweighed by the losses they cause. Many vigilante groups have also been later exposed for their illegal, harmful and destructive tactics which did the world more harm than good.
